

The CRD had a great meeting in March. With a dozen residents in attendance, Board Member, Paul Siddall, did a comprehensive laptop/projector presentation which required slightly dimmed lighting to get the full affect of the colored

images against the wall. The Board discussed in detail his proposal to install new fencing at OCP (behind GFS / Red Lobster), along with doubling the size of the dog run. The Board approved the project and the residents in attendance left very happy. This large expenditure is in part due to the savings of \$3,989 per month (\$47,868 for 12 months) from refinancing the loan at a lower interest rate.

In addition, Board Member, Michael Carelli, presented three bids to repair the walkway behind Bank of America that the community owns. This walkway allows residents from Butia Place, Ilex Street, Schefflera Road, Carrollbrook Lane, and Carrollbrook Way to walk behind Bank of America to get to Lake Carroll Way, so they can then cross to get to the Publix Shopping Center. The Board approved this project also, so look for work at both Origianl Carrollwood Park and behind Bank of America to begin soon.

Thanks to Board Member, David O'Donnell, for installing new soap dispensers at White Sands Beach and Scotty Cooper Park. We'll see you all at the CCA Easter Egg Hunt on April 4th.


Toe-side 360



This month we will focus on the toe-side 360. Before learning this spin, you should be comfortable with toe-side 180s. This spin will help with learning a 540 and heelside 3s.

1. Approach and takeoff:

For the toe-side 360, you will want to take a gentle progressive edge with your weight even. Keep your chest up and handle low. By edging too fast, you can put too much tension in the line to make the handle pass. Give the handle a tug as you go up the wake, to keep the handle in close. The key to this 360 spin is to think of this trick as two separate 180s. You want to leave the wake like a normal wake jump: pop first, and then start your 180.





This 360 allows you to pass the handle or land wrapped (blind). At the peak of your jump, you will start the second 180, drop your front hand from the handle and keep looking over your front shoulder. You will want to start spotting your landing as soon as possible. Pull the handle to your lower back. Reach with your front hand for the handle.

3. Landing

Keep your eyes focused on your landing area, do not look at the boat (this will cause you to over-rotate and slip out). Get your weight over your toes and cut away from the wake.





* If you are hitting the other wake when landing, you can lengthen your rope or slow the boat down a bit. This allows you to do the trick with no worries of landing on top of the other wake (a one-wake jump and landing inside of the wake.) Once comfortable, you can shorten the rope and go wake to wake.


