

### **Help Remove Channeled Apple Snails**

Channeled Apple Snails In Lake Carroll

Hello neighbors. You may recall several years ago an article from me in *The Caroler* on this topic. While these things have been around for some time, we

want to make sure that everyone removes them when they find them. These snails are not native to Florida and can really wreak havoc in Florida lakes. They can live five months out of the water and hibernate in the mud during winter. Unfortunately, they don't eat hydrilla, cattails or Brazilian Pepper. The eggs and snails need to be destroyed when they are found. To help slow the spread of more snails, dispose of them in a sealed plastic bag and freeze. Once frozen, put them - still in the bag - into the garbage. Thank you very much for your support and care of our beautiful lake.




### **Carrollwood Fire Station No. 19 Being Replaced** by a Larger Facility in 2016

Perhaps you've seen a big yellow bulldozer menacingly parked near Fire Station No. 19, a facility that has taken thousands of calls from residents of Original Carrollwood and nearby neighborhoods since 1977. Soon, the aging fire station at 13201 North Dale Mabry Highway will be replaced by a much larger, 6,650-square-foot structure. The existing fire station will be demolished, giving way to a new facility that will rise on that same spot by summer 2016.

Currently, five people are staffed at the facility with one fire engine and one rescue unit on site. According to Michelle Van Dyke, Hillsborough County Community Relations Coordinator, construction costs for the new fire station are approximately \$2.1 million. Funding is provided by Impact Fees and Public Safety Improvement Bond Project funds. Folks concerned with longer call response times due to the demolition of the old fire station and construction of the new building need not worry. "Existing fire rescue services will remain in operation during the completion of the new station," Van Dyke says. "Personnel, equipment, and apparatus will be housed in temporary headquarters on site."

The new fire station will have two bays and feature a clean, streamlined appearance fairly similar to the Jimmie B. Keel Regional Library at 2902 W. Bearss Avenue. Those concerned about the appearance of the new fire station can breathe a sigh of relief. The new building's brick veneer, painted stucco walls, and hip-style roofline will integrate well with nearby suburban office buildings and low-density commercial developments in the surrounding area.



## This & That OC REAL ESTATE SELLING YOUR HOME 101

### **4-POINT INSPECTION-ELECTRICAL**

Well folks, brace yourself. If you're planning to sell your home, the new thing is the 4-Point Inspection. More and more insurance companies are



now requiring it before they will write a policy for the buyer. If there are any issues that don't meet their standards, they will require it to be fixed first. Even if you have an AS-IS contract, you as the seller, will end up having to make these repairs at your cost or the buyer will not be able to get insurance and, thus, the mortgage company will not make the loan to the buyer without the home being insurable.

The 4-Points are: Electrical System, Heating System, Plumbing System, and Roof. This month we're going to talk about electrical. The first thing they look for is age. If your sub-panel (that's the inside box where all your trip switches are) is over thirty years old, you are possibly going to have a problem. Over the years, we have modified our homes and, in many cases, this means changes to the electrical systems. There are copper wires and there are aluminum wires, and there are combinations that were often not properly spliced. There are things like doorbell relays tucked away in these boxes which were either ok or overlooked in earlier times that are a no-no now. They are looking for excess numbers of fuses in the box, empty breaker sockets, loose wiring and much more.

Over and above these isolated situations listed above are some specific brands of electrical sub-panel boxes. In the late 60's and 70's, there were some brands (FederalPacific, ITT, Sylvania, etc.) which were branded as suspect for causing house fires. Some of these were used in Original Carrollwood homes. They now have to be replaced when you sell your home. So just remember, before you sell, you may be faced with this bill and it could cost you between \$1500 and \$2500. Please don't be surprised. Plan ahead and it won't be as painful.
