he CRD Board is pleased to announce a major capital improvement at the front entrance to White Sands Beach. The block wall in the center at the front entrance (where the guard sits under the oak tree) should be torn down by the time you are reading this (it was scheduled for June 17th) and will be replaced with a six-foot black wrought iron fence (like Scotty Cooper Park). This has been planned for 12 months. The next step, after this is completed, is to remove the old short chain link rolling gates at the front entrance and replace both the entrance and exit sides with a more modern access control gate system. The new access control gates will not be immediately installed, but will happen in the next three months.

OC resident & retired landscape architect Shirley Pearsall will once again volunteer her talents to design the landscape entrance to WSB after everything is finished. You might recall that Shirley created the landscape design for the community entrance at Dale Mabry Highway & Lake Carroll Way.
