



OC REAL ESTATE

Greetings Carrollwoodians!

In 2010, I bought my first home (well, condo) right on Lake Magdalene. I used to walk off my back patio, jump in my 1985 Ebbtide Dynatrak with a 90 HP, and be fishing within seconds... depending on whether or not the boat started. Any guesses as to what I paid? \$36,001! No, not for the boat, but for the condo! At that time, inventory was through the roof, and short sales and foreclosures were commonplace. Realtors, Buyers, and Sellers had to adapt to a new way of doing business. Two years later, we purchased a home in OC. The market was still cool; however improving, but buyers still had the upper hand. The sellers of the home I purchased came to the table with over \$12,000 just to be able to close. They had no equity and were fortunate to have the capital to cover their difference. By 2016, the median number of days on the market for a home in OC was less than three weeks. Equity was growing steadily. What's my point? Seasons change, markets shift, and Industries evolve. The last

few months in the Real Estate Industry have disrupted how we as professionals operate. Depending on who you speak to, you will hear the negative, the positive, the indifferent, the ignorant, the excited, the exhausted, or some hybrid combination of all the above.

The reality is that agents must put new operating procedures in place. In many aspects, the playing ground is level for the wellseasoned agent and the beginner. Agents who "have been doing this for X number of years" are being forced to change their practices. New agents are none-the-wiser on how things operated "back in the day." We, as professionals, HAVE to adapt. We must get better. Expect more from your agent. In the past, Buyer Agent's commissions were a required field in the MLS. Granted, they could be as low as one dollar, but it was mandatory. Now, that is no longer the case. Commissions are fully negotiable. The buyer, the seller, or a combination of both may pay the buyer's agents. But wait, there's more! Sellers' offerings to buyer's agents can also be negotiated on behalf of the seller by the listing agent to a buyer's agent! Or instead of commission, sellers may offer concessions directly to a buyer. Or they might perhaps not provide anything at all! If this is confusing to you, join the club. Agents, owners, and potential Buyers are navigating these waters together. However, to quote Winston Churchill, "Never let a good crisis go to waste." The excellent will excel, and the mediocre will fail.

Katherine Clapp, 85 July 14, 1939 - September 14, 2024

Katherine (James) Clapp, age 85, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on Saturday, September 14, 2024, in Madison, Alabama. She was born in Parkersburg, WV, on July 14, 1939, to her parents, Daisy Fai and Perry B. James.

Katherine's life centered around family and community. She proclaimed, "One of the JOYS of my adult years of parenting has been to observe the interplay among the four siblings, then as we added the sibs-inlaws to the mix how well we got along! I still like & admire the mix as individuals. Even the four dogs get along!!! I like our family!"

Church activities played a big part in her life too, including the Chancel Choir and Sunday School, and leadership positions such as Youth Counselor, Trustee, Staff Parish Relations, and family life. Katherine sang in the choir, and was frequently a featured soprano soloist, at all the Methodist churches where she was a member. In Tampa, that was Forest Hills United Methodist Church.

The daughter of a Methodist Minister, Katherine grew up all over the South, in West Virginia, Florida, and Alabama. She graduated from Athens High School in Athens, AL, with the Class of 1956, Athens College in June 1959, and married just weeks later. As she once said. "Thus, I got my B.S. the first part of June and my Ph.D. (Roger) later in the same month—quite a feat! Along with a MRS!" Katherine and Roger lived in Huntsville, Alabama, where he worked at Redstone Arsenal as a Research Scientist, until they moved to Florida and built their family home in Original Carrollwood in 1963, when Roger joined the Physics Department faculty at the University of South Florida.

Each of her four children joined the Carrollwood Village Swim Team (CVST) at an early age, starting an 18-year period centered around competitive swimming. She was a Red Cross Water Safety Instructor and Red Cross Canoe Instructor. She became a US Swimming Official, serving as a Stroke and Turn judge, officiating at the age group level, high school, and at a few USF and Tampa U. college (AAU) swim meets. Katherine also served as a Girl Scout (GS) Leader for about eight years and continued as a GS Water Front trainer for longer. "K ~ sea" became her second name: her GS camp name, and the nickname she used teaching swimming. She taught 3-yearold swim classes at Carrollwood Village, including for 3 of her own grandchildren. As a Girl Scout leader for her daughter, Laura, she chaperoned numerous camping and canoeing expeditions. She planned and executed an annual family canoe day trip for the day after Thanksgiving for many years, featuring leftover turkey sandwiches for lunch along the Hillsborough River.

She delivered Meals On Wheels for 40 years, volunteered as an usher (both with Roger) at the Tampa Bay Performing Arts Center/Straz for over 11 years., and was also Election Clerk for the Carrollwood Precinct for many years.

In the autumn of 2023, Katherine and Roger sold their family home of 60 years on Valencia Road in Original Carrollwood and moved to Madison, Alabama, to live closer to family.

Katherine is survived by her loving husband, Dr. Roger W. Clapp Jr., four children: Marney (Greg) Murin, Laura (Jan) Eiras, Roger (Donna) Clapp III, and Larry (Roxanne) Clapp, grandchildren Katie (Eric), Kevin (Paige), Kaitlyn (Kamron), Emily, Marcus; great-grandchildren: Emma, Sasha, Charlie and Hudson; her brother Perry B. James, and sister Dorothea "Dottie" Baxter. All of whom she loved very much. A celebration of life will be announced.
