

he October Board meeting mainly focused on damage assessment from Hurricane Milton. White Sands Beach had to remain closed for a few days due to sewage backup in both restrooms that overflowed under the pavilion. This happens when we lose electricity and the Community's lift stations cannot process the sewage. The Recreation Center & Tennis courts had two large fallen trees and a lot of tree branches. One tree fell over & damaged the tennis fence in the very back. We were able to clear the courts for use the Sunday after the storm. Scotty Cooper Park mainly had a lot of fallen tree branches which were quickly cleared by Community volunteers. At Original Carrollwood Park, three light poles were blown down and several fallen trees. The best cost estimate for damage at the time this article was written is \$20,000, which is manageable.

Also, a big thanks to Hillsborough County Commission Chairman for getting the massive trees that had fallen on Orange Grove Drive and Lake Ridge Roads removed so quickly. He stopped by for a site meeting a couple of times.



community—grandparents, cousins, children, all choosing to live within the same neighborhood, sharing in its unique charm and warmth.







When morning broke, the power was out and neighbors began checking on and helping each other. In the following days, utility workers from across the nation arrived to clear downed trees from utility lines and restore power. Some of the lineworkers spotted in OC came from as far away as Connecticut, Missouri, Georgia, and Ohio.

OC's resilient residents are thankful to all who helped with physical and emotional support.

History of Phoenix Circle

In 1973 my husband, Gilbert, a professor of Anthropology, and I moved with our three young sons from Brockport, NY, to Tampa. He was starting his position as Chair of the Department of Anthropology at the University of South Florida. We purchased a home in Town and Country and in 1972 looked for a home in Carrollwood. Our oldest son was attending Independent Day School. When driving around Carrollwood, we noticed a plowed road which was the location of a plant nursery next to IDS. We were told Sunstate Builders were going to build homes on that property. We contacted the builder, chose a lot in what was then to be Phoenix Circle, and moved into 11727 in February, 1972.

At that time, there was one other occupied home. We met our neighbors, at 11725 Phoenix Circle, the first residents, Sunny and Jerry Brandmeyer, also a Professor at USF, and their 2 young children. I am known as Rainy, and when we met she said, "Hi, I'm Sunny." I replied, "Hi, I'm Rainy," a great beginning. Jerry was an albino and kept all of the giant podocarpus trees for shade in his yard except for a pool area. My lot was covered with the same trees which I wanted to keep until a later date. Jerry called me when a bulldozer was about to cut down the trees, stopped them until I arrived and told them to stop. Some of these trees remain in my yard.



For many years, Phoenix Circle had an abundance of peacocks. At two separate times, a peahen nested near our fireplace. Sometime later I found hatched and broken shells. Once I saw a beautiful albino peacock in front of our house. We became known as the turtle family because we had a small fenced area in our backyard where we enjoyed a variety of turtles. People would frequently bring us their found turtles.

New families moved in, many were professors at USF, some were physicians and attorneys. Most of the new owners had young children. Phoenix Circle was a beautiful last development of Sunstate Builders. It also had a Design Center where I was able to chose details including, cabinets, hardware, wallpaper, carpeting, etc. Our home, except for the building specifications, was our personal design. Independent Day School is directly behind my house and I continue to enjoy hearing the sounds of the children.

Many new families have moved in and out of the various homes. I love seeing all the young families on our street that continues to be a beautiful and desirable place to live. I'm so happy that Andy Fonda returned the Phoenix Circle tradition and gave us a chance to be together for a Fall Harvest Block Party. It was so sweet. Lots of young families and children. Wonderful!




